Points to note

1. Study at school

Students who study at school during the study period after the Final Examination must note the following items:

- (a) School days
 - i> Students must wear <u>proper school uniform</u> as on normal school days, otherwise, first offenders will receive a written warning, and repeated offenders will be punished severely (e.g. bad marks, demerits) and their conducts will be downgraded. The date to start wearing summer school uniform will be notified by the discipline teachers later.
 - ii> Students must return to and leave the school <u>at the same time as other students</u>. Hence, other than recesses, lunch time and after school, students are required to do their revision at the places specified. Staying at the corridors or other places, going to the tuck shop, eating and drinking are not allowed, in order to avoid disturbance to other students who are having their lessons.
 - iii> When other students are having their lessons in classrooms, S.6 students are only limited to studying in the <u>GO4, library or the covered playground</u>. Studying in the <u>library should be on double-lesson basis, during which students</u> are not allowed to leave without permissions of the library teachers (including leaving for the washroom or consultation with teachers about homework matters). Those who study at the covered playground must not disturb any lesson held in that area.
 - iv> Students must <u>sign in and sign out</u> at the General Office by writing down their arrival and departure time.
 - v> Students who are back to school for revision after the mock examination need not to lock their mobile phones. However, they should obey school rules with regard to the mobile phones arrangement. That is, students should switch off their phones before entering the school premises, suspend the usage of mobile phones inside the school campus and stop using mobile phones while crossing the roads. Students violating the above rules will be punished severely.
 - vi> No ball game is allowed during the study period and the HKDSE exam period.

(b) School holidays

To facilitate students' revision during the Chinese New Year and Easter holiday, the school would open Room G03 and G04 for their use and S.6 students must obey the following rules when they go back to school for revision:

- i> Opening dates: **13-14/2**, **20-23/2**, **28/3**, **29/3**, **3/4**, **4/4/2018**
- ii> Opening hours: 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
 - * Students should enter and leave the school in accordance with the school timetable; they should not enter and leave whenever they wish. (Students are allowed to enter the school from 8:45 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. in the morning, enter or leave from 1:05 p.m. to 2:20 p.m. in the afternoon and leave the school from 3:55 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.)
- iii> Students must obey the school rules when they go back to school for revision.
- iv> Students must wear school uniform neatly (please pay attention to the school schedule about the change of summer uniform) when they go back to school for revision. They should study attentively and should not conduct other activities.
- v> The regulation of mobile phones as specified in point 1 (a) v.

2. Enhancement classes

Students <u>must attend</u> the Enhancement classes organized by the school, for more details, please refer to the relevant parents' notice.

- (a) Students must wear proper school uniform.
- (b) No registration at General Office is needed for students who only return to school for enhancement classes.
- (c) Staying at school in the time other than enhancement classes will be considered as

- returning to school for studying. Registration at General Office is necessary.
- (d) Those who are doing their revision at school must stay in **G04**. They must avoid disturbance to other students who are having their lessons.
- (e) If students go to school to consult teachers about problems encountered when doing revision, they must choose to go to school or leave the school when other students are not having their lessons, for example, during lunch time, after school, etc.
- (f) Students must attend their "Enhancement Classes" punctually. If they take leave or leave earlier on the day of Enhancement Classes, they must <u>complete the leave application</u> <u>procedures</u> in accordance with the relevant school rules. Students who are absent without reason would be penalized.
- (g) Students must follow the regulation of mobile phones as specified in point 1 (a) v.

Speech Day

- (a) The 28th Speech Day of S.6 students will be held at school on 19/5/2018 (Saturday).
 - * If suspension of class is announced by the Education Bureau, the rehearsal and ceremony will be postponed to the following Saturday (26th May, 2018) at the same time and venue. Details of the arrangements will be uploaded onto the school webpage (http://www.skhcyss.edu.hk).
- (b) All S.6 students must be present.
- (c) S.6 students must attend the rehearsal on that day at the scheduled time on page 1.
- (d) S.6 students must wear proper <u>summer uniform</u> on that day (boy students must wear the summer shirts and <u>school ties</u>) in accordance with the regulations of school uniform, appearance and hair. Any students who violate the regulations above would be disqualified from participation in the ceremony.
- (e) Report Card, Graduation Certificate, Class Photo and Graduation Photo would be distributed to S.6 students on Speech Day. In addition, S.6 students will also receive their Student Learning Profile on Speech Day. No Report Card is available before the Speech Day. In case of further study or job application, students could apply for copies of Report Card upon the submission of parents' letters. However, please note the school would only be able to provide copies of Report Cards to students when they are ready.
- 4. If S.6 students return to school for the reason of performing activities after HKDSE, they must contact the teachers concerned in advance, and must not disturb other classes or activities in progress.
- 5. S.6 students who return to school for performing activities during the period after their School Last Day / HKDSE and before the Speech Day must wear proper school uniform. After the Speech Day, if students return to school for a short period of time and stay only at the covered playground or the ground floor, students are allowed to wear proper and plain casual wear with the metal school badge. However, students who study in the library or participate in any school activities still need to wear proper school uniform. Students must register at the General Office no matter how long they stay at school. (Students should refer to the "Notes to alumni for attending school activities" in the school website.)
- 6.
